The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. HIGHWAY STAR came away in good order, got set up in the two path, was under a firm hold proceeding along the backstretch, drafted behind the right shoulder of LUCY N ETHEL during the run around the bend, was forced to be kept up hold, lacking the best of options for the last few jumps leading up to the quarter pole, espied enough daylight between opponents up ahead and slithered her way into the four path spinning into the stretch, responded when given her cue, closing enough to begin the final furlong hitched up to the leader, that being the second place finisher, vied with vigour as the widest of a three from that juncture onward and gamely got the job done. CARINA MIA stalked the pacesetter from two to three wide, was in hand issuing a successful takeover shortly after the half had been run, settled into upper stretch and was put to a stronger ride, inched away away to her largest lead the rest of the trip to the eighth pole, but with a pair of rivals lurking dangerously about, one to her right, and the other down on the fence, fought fiercely but couldn't fend off the equally-determined winner. QUEZON was pulling on the left taking residence in the pocket after the start, continued to do so tracking the pacesetter, cut the corner with room enough along the rail corridor to launch a rally, was given its cue and did so, battled as the innermost of three in the last eighth but came up short. ABSATOOTLY pursued the pace three to four wide, the widest of all, on the turn, got sent into path five heading for the three-sixteenths marker, lacked the necessary stretch response. FRIEND OF LIBERTY sluggish travelling in the two path, swung seven wide into upper stretch and had no offering. LUCY N ETHEL narrowly broke in front and retained the lead, got guided over towards the inside, carved out the pace, from slightly off the inside, was set to a hand ride getting displaced by the second place finisher late on the bend, remained a prominent factor for a little while longer and backed away.
