GANGSTER went to the front, raced inside on the first turn, set the clear pace, vied inside on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, responded well when put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, drew off under the whip into the final sixteenth then proved much the best under a strong hand ride. INDIAN TRAIL went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came under the whip while inside of SECURITIZ in upper stretch and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. SECURITIZ went two to three wide on the first turn, was unhurried in the back half of the field, dropped back while in the three path early on the far turn, was roused before the three-eighths pole, angled five wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths, was put to the whip while outside in upper stretch and narrowly missed the place. ALL RISE went three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, raced three wide while tracking the leader on the far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, had the rider lose his whip at the top of the stretch, battled under a strong hand ride in the drive and just missed the trifecta. GODREVEY settled on the inside, continued to save ground while under intermittent urging on the far turn, came off the rail into the stretch then hesitated behind a rival, dropped back to the inside then came under a drive, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and failed to rally. ARBITRATOR bumped with CAPTAIN TIM nearing the first turn, dropped in to race inside on that bend, tracked the pace while rated, saved ground on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths, chased into upper stretch then tired. TRADESMAN raced in the two path on the first turn, moved up to be well placed just off the pace, came under urging while in the two path on the far turn, chased into the stretch and weakened. CAPTAIN TIM bumped with ARBITRATOR nearing the first turn, raced in the two path on that bend, settled off the pace, was urged along in the two path on the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch while under the whip and came up empty. RIVER DATE raced in the two path on the first turn, settled at the back, passed the half-mile pole under urging, went four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten.
