By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box; \$1,000 additional to start. This race includes an additional \$50,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for nominees only. The NYRA purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 2 on the turf, 4 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstakes, 6 lbs. A trophy to winning owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. The New York Racing Association will present trophies to the winning trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. ALEXANDER TANGO (IRE) was taken back after the start, was rated along outside, rallied five wide approaching the stretch, closed stoutly from the far outside and was up late after a rousing finish. BIT OF WHIMSY raced close up outside while in hand, raced three wide on both turns, responded when called on turning for home and dug in gamely while between rivals in the stretch. SHARP SUSAN showed good speed while well in hand, prompted the pace from the outside and stayed on gamely to the finish. COSTUME (GB) was rated along early, raced between rivals, angled out in the stretch and finished gamely outside. CHESTORIA raced in hand early, rallied three wide nearing the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.. VALBENNY (IRE) was outrun early along the inside, came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. MISSVINSKI was rated along inside, saved ground and lacked a rally when called on in upper stretch. STREET SOUNDS raced close up inside, chased the pace and had no response when roused. NEW EDITION was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and gave way in the final furlong. RUTHERIENNE raced in hand outside, was wide much of the way, had no response when asked and tired in the drive.
