The NYRA purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 2 on the turf, 4 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstakes, 6 lbs. A trophy to winning owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. The New York Racing Association will present trophies to the winning trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 26, 2006 with 18 Nominations.

MAGNIFICENT SONG was unhurried while outrun early, advanced between rivals on the second turn, angled to the outside entering the stretch, responded when set down, finished fast outside and was clear under the wire, driving. TAKE THE RIBBON raced close up early while in hand, rallied three wide on the second turn, earned a short lead in the stretch but had no response for the winner while continuing on with good energy to hold the place. JADE QUEEN was rated along early, advanced outside on the second turn, rallied wide into the stretch and finished well outside. CHAIBIA (IRE) raced close up along the inside, saved ground throughout and failed to quicken despite room along the rail in the stretch. MAXXI ARTE (IRE) raced with the pace from the outside, put in a run approaching the stretch and faded in the final furlong. LA MOTTIE (GB) was rated along inside, saved ground, angled out in the stretch and lacked a rally. QUITE A BRIDE was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. CARRIAGE TRAIL stumbled at the start, was outrun early, put in a four wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. DELMARVA was taken in hand after the start, raced inside and had no response when called on. MAY NIGHT was rank in the gate, raced inside and tired. IN RETURN raced wide throughout and tired.
