GRAY CAT forwardly positioned along inside into stretch, lacked bid. GOLDEN SPRINGS raced six wide from off pace into stretch, no factor in drive. IMMA BE A WILDCAT hustled to front, set pace for half, faded. SERENA WHIP stalked leaders for half, dropped back.
