ROYAL OBSESSION came in a bit as the field was sent on its way, had the rider attempt to pull off the nearest foe and did so but only temporarily, leaned upon DREAMS TO REALITY for several strides afterwards when put in tight by FLORA DORA, got bumped, sat reserved in the two path for over six furlongs, tipped into the fourth one in preparation for the stretch, entered it just as wide and under a drive, gained belatedly while the winner was in hand for the last three to four jumps. MO D'AMOUR was rated prompting the pacesetter from the two path in the initial stages, departed the backstretch being positioned between opponents, challenged for command as three-quarters was being reached, wasn't able to take command, remained promienlty placed to upper stretch before tiring in the final furlong. DREAMS TO REALITY made slight contact with ROYAL OBSESSION after that foe came inward, continued to go shoulder to shoulder with the aforementioned rival, due to pressure from FLORA DORA as she was working her way towards the rail after the break, got bumped off stride near the finish line the first tirm, recovered and tucked along the rail, rode it on the first turn, was eased into the two path at the head of the backstretch, continued to take up the chase from there on the far turn, got fanned into six path during the initial portion of the stretch, had no rally, FLORA DORA strung out three wide on both turns, gave way. CLAIR DE LUNE broke on top and maintained the advantage, was rated setting the fractions from the rail, with MO D'AMOUR in close attendance out in path two, had the winner draw up to apply pressure of her own approaching the end of the backstretch, required stronger and stronger hand urging from the pilot to fend off the two challengers, appeared to yield at the midway point on
