ALWAYS SHOPPING attained a forward position after brushing with the second place finisher at the start, settled into the two path in time to begin the journey around the clubhouse bend, was rated along in path two prompting POSITIVE SPIRIT, chiseled away at the deficit after departing the backstretch, until directly abreast by the five-sixteenths pole, saw the pilot sitting chilly atop the mount going at it eye to eye with the runner up, even with the nemeis under a drive by this juncture, spun approximately three wide and was given her cue, came in slightly when instructed to switch leads heading to the three-sixteenths marker, met up with an incoming POSITIVE SPIRIT, resulting in some contact between them, shook it to poke a head down in front by the eighth pole, out-dueled a very determined foe during the ensuing sixteenth and edged away. POSITIVE SPIRIT bumped lighlty with the winner at the start, grabbed the advantage in short order and made it onto the inside route by the crown of the first turn, showed the way, tailed by the winner out in path two, saw that foe crank up the pressure in a piecemeal manner beginning from the half mile pole, was on near even terms with set down to a drive in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, was coming out slightly as the top one was coming in a bit herself approaching the three-sixteenths pole, bumped solidly with that rival, began the final furlong trailing by a narrow margin, put up a spirited fight for another sixteenth before finally getting shaken off. OFF TOPIC was sighted straddling the right rim of the inside route keeping watch on the front runners, continued along on the same set up all the way to the end of the second bend, got called upon for the drive, made no headway down the lane. PROUD EMMA strung out three wide on both turns, came under a ride nearing the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the lane, failed to gain ground appreciably. ESPRESSO SHOT unhurried two wide until the conclusion of the backstretch, was gradually maneuvered ino path four from the top of the far turn to its midway point, stepped into the stretch and lacked the necessary stretch. AFLEET DESTINY away one length the tardiest but otherwise cleanly after tossing her head just as the field was about to released, saved ground to upper stretch while trailing throughout.
