UNCONTESTED stumbled then bumped with COLONEL SHARP leaving the gate, quickly recovered and advanced within himself to join LONG MAY YOU RUN from the inside, edged clear nearing the half mile marker and was nursed along around the turn, was guided to about the three path entering the lane, opened up after being asked for his best leaving the three sixteenths, kept on under right handed rousing and held sway. MAJESTIC DUNHILL, patiently handled off the pace while saving some ground, gathered momentum mid turn, worked between foes into the lane then finished strong to gain. LAKI, between foes early, edged up past the half mile marker and stalked, shifted four wide into the lane and continued willingly to the line. DO SHARE was squeezed back soon after the break, commenced a run while five wide leaving the far turn, angled and circled about eight wide into the lane, straightened and finished with interest. ROCKINN ON BYE, off the pace and removed from the inside, steadied briefly past the five sixteenths, altered in near mid stretch and offered a mild kick. HOME RUN MAKER, under a snug hold while saving ground, angled out to split rivals after a half mile, angled six wide making a menacing run then failed to sustain in the final furlong. STILL HAVING FUN, fractious in the gate, was in a bit tight at the break, settled off the pace while saving some ground, eased out and advanced between horses mid turn, shifted to about the five path for the drive but lacked a solid finish. CORDMAKER was squeezed back at the start, settled well back while off the rail, circled extremely wide into the lane and had some late action. LIFE IN SHAMBLES, four to five wide around the turn, needed more. SOMETHING AWESOME, bumped at the break, was unhurried early, angled out around the turn, came about nine wide for the drive and only had a mild run. LONG MAY YOU RUN sped to the early lead, was headed from the inside near the five eighths pole, prompted the issue outside the winner, race five wide under pressure into the lane and gave way in mid stretch. MOE TROUBLE, urged along off the rail, raced between foes past the three eighths pole and gave way. IT'S GOOD TO BE US stalked the early pace outside rivals, was under a drive leaving the far turn, failed to kick on and faltered mid turn. COLONEL SHARP, towards the inside, provided some early pressure then dropped back.
