By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 2 lbs.; Maidens, 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday September 12, 2015 with 14 Nominations. MELODIC broke inward, making some contact with the left side of the gate, showed no effects from it, was eased back early down the backstretch and thus judiciously kept apart from a three-ply pace dispute that had just gotten started, was coaxed along in the two path staying within range of the front runners, proceeded to get angled outward from the five-sixteenths marker, swung four wide lurking a major player for the stretch run, responded positively when fully asked, drove to the lead by the end of the furlong grounds and kicked away. FROSTY MARGARITA shied inward and away rom SURPRISE CAMEO after the field was sent off and running, brushed with SUPER SURPRISE soon afterwards, advanced together with the previously-named opponent to confront SURPRISE CAMEO, disputed the pace from the three path as the widest of a trio all the way into upper stretch, was at that stage in the race when finally switched over to encouragement, proved no match while holding more than sufficiently enough to garner the place. SURPRISE CAMEO came in sharply springing from the gate, was corrected but not before pressuring the two closest rivals into shying towards the rail themselves, took the lead and momentarily shook free, was joined by two others midway down the backstretch, vied to fend them off, was the first to have its pilot call upon the mount for some response, this occurring in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, relinquished in upper stretch and weakened. SUPER SURPRISE shied inward after the start, due to pressure originated from her uncoupled stable mate, brushed with FROSTY MARGARITA, moved up to hook up with the leader, contended for the lead from between foes to upper stretch having been set down by the quarter pole, tired. BEN'S GIRL had the rider take hold a few strides after the start, reacting to another heading her way.. saved ground to the quarter pole, was put to urging cutting the corner into the stretch, failed to fire appreciably after being angled out.
