Purse \$100,000 *GLENS FALLS H.(GRADE III) INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination; A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 may be made by Wednesday, August 30. \$500 to pass the entry box, \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added. All entrants will be required to pay entry and starting fees. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. **DIRT Weights;** Three year olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2005-06 allowed 2lbs.; A sweepstake on the dirt in 2005-06; or four races on the dirt, 4lbs.; three races on the dirt, 6lbs.; two races on the dirt, 8lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 19, 2006 with 21 Nominations.

Dark Bay or Brown Mare, (Jan), by Monsun (GER) - Noble Pearl (GER) by Dashing Blade (GB). Trainer Attfield L. Roger. Bred by Gestut Etzean(GER).

NOBLE STELLA (GER) eased back settling just behind the leader on the first turn, raced in good position along the backstretch, rapidly closed the gap on the turn, charged to the front in upper stretch then drew away under strong right hand encouragement. LATICE (IRE) was rated just behind the leaders for a mile, followed the winner leaving the far turn, angled three wide at the quarter pole then finished willingly to clearly best the others. LOUVE ROYALE (IRE) was outrun to the turn, saved ground leaving the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. WAIT IT OUT was unhurried for a mile while three wide then failed to threaten with a mild late run from outside. SABELLINA sprinted clear on the first turn, set the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch and tired from her early efforts. QUIERO GANAR steadied after stumbling at the start, raced between horses while three wide along the backstretch, angled four wide on the turn and faded in the stretch. OLAYA steadied and was bumped between horses nearing the first turn and failed to threaten thereafter. MILWAUKEE (FR) in hand early, raced within striking distance between horses to the turn and lacked a further response. ROWDY steadied and was bumped along the inside nearing the first turn, raced in midpack along the rail to the turn then gave way approaching the stretch.
