WHITE ROSE settled on the inside, moved closer on the final turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, eased off the hedge in upper stretch then made a bid, battled with the runner-up under a right-handed whip in the final furlong and proved best under good handling. EASTERN BELLE (GB) was taken back between horses on the initial straightaway, settled on the outside while racing in the two path, angled four late on the final bend, rallied to make a bid in upper stretch, battled with the winner under a right-handed whip in the final furlong and missed. REGARDEZ (GB) settled on the inside while towards the rear, moved closer while two then three wide on the final turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a left-handed whip while on the outside, drifted in outside the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the show. LADY OF GOLD lightly hit the inside of the gate at the start, was unhurried while in the two path through the first two turns, lingered at the back, saved ground on the far turn, was asked around the five-sixteenths, altered course to the outside from behind opponents in upper stretch and finished with late energy to improve position. EVIDENTLY was reserved on the inside, moved closer late on the backstretch, went around the final turn in the two path, waited behind horses after turning into the stretch, dropped to the hedge near the three-sixteenths then was roused, came back off the inside at the furlong marker, entered the final sixteenth between horses and flattened out. MAXIMOVA pulled her way to the front while eager, set the pace through fast fractions while near the hedge, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost the advantage while under a right-handed whip in upper stretch then gave way. CEISTEACH (IRE) hit the gate at the start then bumped with a rival, was taken in hand, raced in the two path on the first turn, dropped to the hedge turning into the stretch for the first time while tugging at the bit, raced inside through the second turn, continued to track the pace, ranged up in the two path on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and capitulated. BOCAIUVA (IRE) bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, settled towards the rear while near the hedge, moved out before the final turn, was urged along while three then four wide on that bend and failed to respond. GOLDY ESPONY (FR) bumped with BOCAIUVA at the start then was hustled, went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the final turn and had nothing left.
