Chestnut Filly, (Mar), by Street Cry (IRE) - Holiday Runner by Meadowlake. Trainer bin Suroor Saeed. Bred by Steve Barberino(KY).

SEVENTH STREET drifted wide on the first turn, raced well off the rail while pressing the pace along the backstretch, angled in a bit while battling heads apart on the first turn, was carried out slightly at the quarter pole, relinquished the lead to SPRITELY in upper stretch, fought back gamely to reclaim the lead inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear under strong urging. MISS ISELLA was outrun early after breaking slowly, moved between horses entering the backstretch, raced in hand for five furlongs, dropped back a bit nearing the quarter pole, closed the gap in upper stretch then battled back between horses to narrowly gain the place. SPRITELY angled in on the first turn, raced in good position while saving ground for six furlongs, came through along the rail to opened a clear advantage in upper stretch, led into deep stretch and yielded in the final seventy yards. WEATHERED was carried five wide on the first turn, continued wide for six furlongs, made a run to threaten on the turn and flattened out. COLOR ME UP angled in on the first turn, set the pace to the turn, drifted out at the quarter pole and gave way. LUNA VEGA trailed throughout.
