By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$3,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees can be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 15, 2014 with 25 Nominations. (Clear 36)

CLASSIC POINT attained a prominent position after the start, prompted the leader towards the two path, inched up towards that foe as three-quarters was being completed, turned for home fully latched on to SWEET WHISKEY and having been put a hard drive, won the tussle during the ensuing furlong to emerge as the new leader, came under assault from the second place finisher shortly afterwards, drifted out several paths, after some left handed stick work, to meet the challenger, dug in gamely to preserve the decision. PRINCESS VIOLET strung out four wide on the turn, picked up interest nearing the quarter pole, spun towards the eight path heading for the three-sixteenths pole, winding up the widest of all, got straightened away and closed in readily on CLASSIC POINT, loomed boldly by deep stretch, finished with good determination, but failed to go past an equally-determined foe, while shying out a path or so in the last few jumps. MOMENT IN DIXIE took the overland route and finished with good courage to earn the show award. SWEET WHISKEY broke alertly and maintained the advantage, got guided over closer to the rail nearing the conclusion of the backstretch, continued to be rated along during the next quarter, with the eventual winner slowly increasing her presence, got pounced upon by that rival as six furlongs was being completed, was let out, offered some resistance before yielding in midstretch, weakened steadily thereafter. PLAYFUL LOVE departed the backstretch from the four path, was put to a drive leaving the five-sixteenths pole, had no rally. STREET GIRL saved ground to upper stretch, went on to mainly improve position after getting angled outward. WILLET in the three path midpoint on the turn, was six wide by upper stretch, lacked the needed response. TAPIT'S WORLD ducked out after springing forth from the starting gate, got checked and pulled away in time to prevent any contact with any of the nearest opponents, kept watch on the pacesetter from the pocket, entered the stretch and backed away. ZUCCHINI FLOWER forwardly placed in the three path for three-quarters, swung a couple of paths wider into the stretch, gave way. GEEKY GORGEOUS loosely drafted behind the leader was placed four wide at the head of the stretch, had little left and tired. ENDLESS CHATTER rode the rail, was put to encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, failed to fire and backed away.
