By subscription of \$250 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,250 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$2,500 in addition to the entry and starting fees can be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 19, 2016 with 17 Nominations. (Clear 48)

Chestnut Filly, (Mar), by Girolamo - Stolen Star by Cat Thief. Trainer Rodrigo A. Ubillo. Bred by Chester Broman & Mary R. Broman (NY).

HIGHWAY STAR four wide in pursuit from just off the pace, got set down continuing four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive issuing a challenge through the final eighth, drifted out under a near sided stick poking a nose in front seventy yards from the finish and lightly herding out HIGH RIDGE ROAD, then just held on to prevail winning the nod on the wire in game fashion. HIGH RIDGE ROAD bumped at the start by BURN CONTROL who broke outwards, chased three wide from just off the leader, got set down at the head of the stretch and was nudged six wide as BAR OF GOLD looked for an optimal path five wide, traded leans with that rival until near the eighth pole, rallied latched on the top pair through the final sixteenth shying out when being lightly herded a bit late on and just missed at the finish. WONDER GAL established the front and knocked heads in hand along the inside with BURN CONTROL to her outside, shook off that rival nearing the quarter pole, swung just off the inside for home roused for the drive, inched away under a drive coming under threat from a pair through the final eighth, dug in and was headed seventy yards from the finish and ran on clear for the show honors. BAR OF GOLD just off the inside in hand in range of the front, swung five wide for home lacking optimal clearance in her lane due to her stable mate HIGHWAY STAR who drifted out slightly, leaned on HIGH RIDGE ROAD and was in turn leaned on until near the three-sixteenths, got roused at that station, dug in between foes briefly before weakening through the final sixteenth while along for the last major share. CAYMAN CROC chased just off the inside from the rear under encouragement from the five-sixteenths, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. CAMILLE CLAUDEL chased the pace along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, weakened in the stretch. BURN CONTROL broke out at the start bumping HIGH RIDGE ROAD, dueled in hand from the two path with WONDER GAL to her inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and was shaken off a bit, swung three wide at the head of the stretch and tired.
