LAVA MAN stumbled at the start but quickly recovered and prompted the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the first turn and stalked the pace, bid three deep into the second turn then battled outside MAGNUM on that turn, put a head in front into the stretch and held on tenaciously under urging while between foes late. ACE BLUE (BRZ) had speed three deep then dueled outside MAGNUM and briefly put a head in front into the backstretch, stalked off the rail nearing and on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and gamely re-bid outside foes late to just miss. SUPER FROLIC pulled early, chased off the rail then inside on the second turn and into the stretch and willingly split foes at the wire. MAGNUM (ARG) had speed between horses then angled in entering the first turn, dueled off the inside, inched away on the backstretch, fought back off the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, drifted in through the final furlong and continued willingly to the end. SEEK GOLD angled in early then came off the inside into the first turn, chased outside a rival on the backstretch, dropped back leaving the second turn and weakened.
