By subscription of \$200 each on or before November 11, 2006 or by supplementary nomination of \$10,000 each at time of entry. \$1,000 to pass the entry box; \$1,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 119 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. The Golden Rod Stakes winner will automatically be nominated to the 2007 Kentucky Oaks, as far as nomination fee is concerned. Closed Saturday, November 11, 2006 with 28 nominations. (Clear 59)

Bay Filly, (Mar), by Orientate - Oatsee by Unbridled. Trainer Nafzger A. Carl. Bred by Bentley L. Smith(KY).

LADY JOANNE, up close between foes three wide early, pulled the rider forward when full of run upon going a half, headed front-running CHANGE UP just prior to going six furlongs, lost the advantage back to that one in the upper stretch, then came again under left-handed urging to move clear late. CHANGE UP moved to a narrow advantage early while near the inside, was a big eager while dueling inside of COHIBA MISS, was engaged by the winner before going a half, lost the edge to LADY JOANNE on the far turn, recaptured the front-end in the upper stretch but could not sustain the necessary momentum in the late going as second best. HIGH HEELS taken in hand inside soon after the break, continued near the inside until approaching the final quarter, eased out four or five wide for the drive, loomed prominently for the last eighth but wasn't good enough. COHIBA MISS went up at once to contest the pace outside of front-running CHANGE UP three or four wide, continued forwardly for six furlongs and weakened. WELLOFAPRIZE, within striking distance and racing near the inside for three-quarters, worked her way out five wide entering the stretch, swerved out suddenly at the three-sixteenths pole and lacked a further account. PRO PINK, within striking distance and three or four wide to the head of the stretch, weakened gradually. LADY CORREDOR raced four or five wide and never menaced. TIME'S MISTRESS broke slowly in the air and wasn't a factor. LITTLEBITABLING followed the leaders in a striking position five wide to the end of the backstretch and tired.
