**Bay Filly, (Mar), by Swiss Yodeler - Domasco Lake by Meadowlake. Trainer Hollendorfer Jerry. Bred by Mr. & Mrs. Larry D. Williams(CA).**

SWISS LAKE YODELER rated kindly four wide just off the dueling leaders, came under pressure mid way on the final turn, leveled off to her best stride when switching leads near mid stretch, forged to command under left handed pressure a sixteenth out then edged away while kept alert. MOVING DESERT dueled three wide under rating, shook clear after six furlongs, met the challenge of the winner in mid stretch, battled to the sixteenth marker then gave way grudgingly. ROVENNA stalked the contested pace while two wide traveling inside a rival, was put to a strong ride past the five sixteenths marker, angled out a bit in upper stretch then could only muster a mild response while narrowly getting the show. HARLINGTON'S ROSE, away alertly, dueled inside MOVING DESERT for nearly six furlongs, gave hard chase past the three sixteenths pole then faded a bit in the final sixteenth. STOLE A KISS bobbed inward at the break, was a bit rank behind a rival nearing the first turn, dropped to the rail in early backstretch, angled out three wide leaving the far turn but lacked a solid stretch kick.

MEINERTZHAGENI, taken in hand early, made some progress between rivals nearing the quarter pole, swung five wide entering the stretch but failed to sustain her run. WHATSALLTHEDRAMA, in a bit tight at the break, lagged back, saved ground into the stretch, angled out, steadied briefly approaching the furlong pole, angled in some and had belated interest. TIME FOR ANGIE lost ground five wide down the backstretch and gave way. CAL GAL, rank under restraint heading towards the first turn, angled four wide for the backstretch run, chased between rivals nearing the far turn then weakened. SMOOTH IT, in tight along the rail entering the first turn, regrouped and edged up to gain a stalking spot, raced forwardly to the far turn, faltered and was eased in the final sixteenth.
