HEARTS OF RED bumped with ZO IMPRESSIVE in the early going, stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones. THE CAT'S ALL THAT chased the pace off the rail to nearing the top of the stretch and tired. YARA set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. CAPTIVATING LASS tracked the pace four wide into the far turn and faded. AND WHY NOT was not a factor. EMMA'S ENCORE trailed.
