COACH ROCKS was allowed to settle early inside, began moving in the two-path entering the far turn, ranged up outside TAKE CHARGE PAULA four or five wide as they left the others behind near the top of the lane, was out in the middle of the track through a long drive and edged away in the last 70 yards. TAKE CHARGE PAULA argued the pace between horses heading up the backstretch, shifted in when EIGHT THIRTYONE called it quits, dueled inside ALTER MOON into the far turn, allowed that one to go clear briefly, went around to retake the lead with a quick move a quarter-mile out, was well out in the track battling inside COACH ROCKS turning for home, drifted out yielding late but was a mile clear of the rest. PRINCESS WARRIOR washed out going to the post, bumped lightly with BLONDE BOMBER a couple times after the start, raced three wide in the second flight early, entered the picture with a four-wide run midway on the far turn, but flattened out from the quarter-pole home. TELL YOUR MAMA raced within striking range at or near the three-path for six furlongs, and lacked a further response. ALTER MOON felt the whip at the break, moved four then three wide around the first turn to join the leaders outside, dueled outside TAKE CHARGE PAULA heading to the far turn, briefly went clear between calls, then weakened after being displaced for command near the quarter-pole and dropped back. BLONDE BOMBER was jostled around between PRINCESS WARRIOR and DAISY after the start, and raced well back throughout. CACHE raced within range of the leaders at or near the inside, and had no response on the rail through the lane. SILVER BAY raced two to three wide on the turns and faded after six furlongs. MIHRAB washed out prior to the start, and went along mostly three wide far back. DAISY bumped lightly with BLONDE BOMBER for a few strides after the start, and dropped far back before completing a half-mile. EIGHT THIRTYONE was put to the whip being hard-used to get the early lead, battled inside TAKE CHARGE PAULA and ALTER MOON and was done by the end of the backstretch.
