By subscription of \$100 due on or before December 1, 2006, with the following eligibility payments: \$100 due on or before November 1, 2007. \$250 due on or before March 1, 2008 ; \$350 due on or before June 1, 2008; \$500 to pass the entry box, \$750 to start. All monies to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 5% of purses won to be awarded to the stallion nominator. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 other than maiden or two races other than maiden or claiming allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; a race other than claiming, 6 lbs. LOOKIN AT HER shot out of the starting gate to grab command, set the pace slightly off the inside, extended his advantage after being put to encouragement, then maintained a safe margin under vigorous handling. **TALL POPPI** tracked the leader while racing along the inside, was asked for response approaching the quarter pole, failed to cut into the leader's margin during the stretch drive, but held well to secure the place. **FOTOGRAFIA** bumped at the start, was no match for the top one during the stretch drive. **GARGANTUA** sluggish leaving the starting gate, outkicked weak ones during the stretch run. **BITABAZ** bumped at the start, had no rally. **EARLY RESPONSE** bumped at the start, failed to threaten off a ground-saving journey. **HEAD HEART HOOF** was steadied while being rank throughout. **SCOOTY THE PRO** displayed brief foot.
