1 $\frac{1}{8}$ MILES. (1.421) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 (US \$204,340) *GREY S. (GRADE III) FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS*. By subscription of \$200 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$2,000 when making entry. The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 2% to fifth, 1% to sixth, 1% to seventh, 1% to eighth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 once at a mile or over, or a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 twice at any distance, allowed 3 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 once at any distance, 5 lbs.; Of a race other than maiden or claiming or restricted allowance at a mile or over, 7 lbs. (No Canadian Bred Allowance.) Final entries to be made at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$4,000, which includes the entry fee. (Closed with 25 Nominations). (Cloudy 7)

RIVER SEVEN stalked the pace in hand, bid late turn, dueled into the stretch, came out a bit in the final furlong then drove to the lead in the final 16th. TESSERON, away a step slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled five-wide late on the far turn and finished determinedly. INDIANO JONES, also away a step slowly, raced off the pace, chased three-wide into the stretch then rallied late outside. FIVE IRON pulled to the early lead, set a reserved pace, quickened midturn but was engaged late turn, dueled from the rail then yielded midstretch. UNCAPTURED stalked the pace, was shuffled back early on the backstretch, remained in range, chased four-wide into the stretch, was checked behind RIVER SEVEN in the final furlong and evened out. MERCENARY stalked from the rail, chased into the stretch, finished gamely but did not menace. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON UNCAPTURED AGAINST RIVER SEVEN FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS DISALLOWED
