HARTFORD broke inwards making some contact with SLIP BY, was righted, then settled into stride between foes, steadily moved to terms with a rival on the pace in the second furlong attending that foe's tempo, moved to prompt that foe racing into the bend, edged forward to a narrow advantage while being urged to turn back a challenge from H TOWN BROWN racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady response to assert himself and draw well clear late under some mild hand urging. The latter broke readily to gain terms with a rival on the pace, conceded the lead to that foe to stalk the leaders under rating along the inside racing into the bend, was urged to challenge the leader while splitting foes, then shifting out three deep racing into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. BORSEGGIATORE, urged to the lead while angling to the inside in the opening stages, disputed the pace inside the eventual winner racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. SLIP BY broke a bit slowly then was bumped at the start, settled in hand tracking the leaders out of striking distance racing to the turn and never gained contention. AGAINSOME, forwardly placed three deep in the opening stages stalking just off the first flight, was fanned four wide nearing upper stretch and steadily faded from contention. ALL THAT BRASS switched off the inside early tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance but steadily retreated racing into upper stretch.
