COWBOY HARDWARE away slowly labored trailing the field through the turn, began to respond in upper stretch circling out to mid track, hit full stride inside the sixteenth pole blowing past a foursome late to win going away. **BAIRDS VILLAGE** slow early would vary little through the turn, shied out from an angling **COWBOY HARDWARE** in upper stretch, responding late from the seven path came widest to grab place on the wire. **FOREST PARK** sent hard pressing a moderate pace through the turn, came between horses in upper stretch, was holding well when overwhelmed from the outside late. **DE BRANDON BOY** broke sharply joining **FOREST PARK** on the early pace, continued to contest in a four way battle from the quarter pole, extended on the rail down the lane gave more though outfinished. **THE STUDENT (ARG)** crowded early was rushed to contention on the turn, going all through the lane would be out finished between horses. **MONKEY HILL** tracked early angling out to bid on the turn, ceding in upper stretch could not regroup. **HEAD MASTER D** dropped back early, coming empty to upper stretch was put away easing late.
