GIRVIN trailed the field in the early stages, advanced between rivals on the backstretch, moved up three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the lane, rallied steadily outside, surged late outside and was just up for the win. MCCRAKEN settled two wide off the pace, raced three wide on the backside, made a strong four wide bid on the far turn, rallied to take charge in upper stretch, dug in gamely in the final furlong and was nailed on the wire. PRACTICAL JOKE broke in and was bumped at the start, pulled a bit entering the first turn, tracked inside, advanced on the far turn, waited for room nearing the quarter pole, came three wide into the stretch, rallied inside of GIRVIN and dug in gamely late between horses. IRISH WAR CRY raced close up while three wide, stalked three wide, bid three wide on the turn, dueled into the stretch, dug in gamely in upper stretch then weakened. TIMELINE hesitated and was bumped at the start, then was in tight along the rail and steadied entering the clubhouse turn, pushed his way through between rivals to contest the pace, vied two wide on the backside, dueled between rivals on the far turn and tired. BATTLE OF MIDWAY hesitated, brushed the gate, was bumped and steadied at the start, rushed up along the rail to set the pace, dueled inside and tired. HENCE raced off the pace inside, swung wide entering the stretch and had no rally.
