1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.442) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *HERECOMESTHEBRIDE S. (GRADE III) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEAR OLDS*. Free nomination by Saturday, February 20, 2010, \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$1,500 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$90,000, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry at a fee of \$6,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a grad stakes over a mile on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf 4 lbs., of two races other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over on the turf 6 lbs. In the event this stakes is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, February 20, 2010 with 34 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth (Rail at 96 feet). (Clear 68)

**Chestnut Filly, (Feb), by Lemon Drop Kid - Confidently by Storm Cat. Trainer Kimmel C. John. Bred by Chester Broman & Mary R. Broman(NY).**

**KHANCORD KID** set the pace along the rail, edged clear in the stretch, then was fully extended to last over **APPLE CHARLOTTE**. The latter, unhurried after being checked from between rivals in the early going, was angling out when she clipped heels leaving the far turn, recovered and rallied to be up for the place. **UPPERLINE** stalked the pace three wide, was outmoved in early stretch, then responded to pressure and was gaining on the winner late while being outfinished for the place. **CHECK THE LABEL** stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch, then didn't do enough late. **MUSICAL ROMANCE** outrun while saving ground, angled out for the drive and closed with a belated rally to dead heat with **DYNAZAPER**. The latter, pressed the pace outside **KHANCORD KID**, gained a brief lead from that rival on the backstretch, continued to press that rival into the stretch and was outfinished. **IN THE ROUGH** stalked the pace after being steadied in the early going, steadied again in behind **APPLE CHARLOTTE** leaving the far turn and tired. **SPLENDID SOUND** reserved off the pace after being steadied in the early going, raced three wide around the far turn and faltered. **PROFITEROLES** steadied in the early going, raced in contention four wide around the far turn, then faded.
