**SMART ENOUGH** dueled early then sprinted clear sharply approaching the turn, set the pace then held sway under a steady drive through the stretch. **FIELD COMMISSION**, well off the pace to the top of the stretch, raced four-wide then rallied willingly between foes and got up late for 2nd. **HEROS REWARD** raced off the pace, closed late turn, angled out upper stretch and finished all out. **LEGAL MOVE** raced off the pace, was hustled from midturn, angled out at the top of the stretch and rallied. **YANKEE INJUNUITY** raced midpack along the rail, was hustled late turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out late. **MR. NIGHTLINGER** dueled early, was headed late backstretch then stalked on the turn, chased from the top of the stretch but evened out. **TRUE VINDICATION**, rated off the pace, saved ground but lacked the necessary closing response. **TRUE TO TRADITION** dueled and also headed late backstretch, was steadied slightly in tight quarters early turn, stalked to the stretch then chased in the stretch but flattened out. **SHADOWLESS**, rated off the pace, angled from the second path to five-wide on the turn but never reached contention. **STUCK IN TRAFFIC**, up close early, stalked on the turn, chased four-wide into the stretch and tired.
