**1 1/4 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.45) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 HILL PRINCE S. (GRADE III) INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.** By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$5,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One race allowed 3 lbs.; of a Grade Two on the turf in 2014 allowed 5 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, September 20, 2014 with 22 Nominations. (Clear 67)

RING WEEKEND took up position in the middle of the field, sat well rated at or very close to the inside route until the quarter pole, was along the hedge entering the stretch, scurried into contention during the later stages of the run through the furlong grounds, found room to slip into two path and did so in the vicinity of the furlong marker, took over in the final seventy yards, came out after a couple of left handed shots, bumping soundly with the runner up in the shadow of the wire. DADDY'S KID three wide on the opening bend, was one path wider on the subsequent one, swung into the stretch and was let out, gained ground readily during the ensuing furlong, was a half body length behind the top one when bumped into by that rival right near the finish line. SMOOTH DADDY broke in front and maintained the advantage, was sent over towards the inside, rated kindly setting the splits, with SHELTON in attendance from the two path, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, got set down leaving that station, dug in tenaciously protecting the lead for the next eighth, but with the top one now clear enough to go after him in earnest, released the lead well past the sixteenth pole then weakened into the show slot. PUMPKIN RUMBLE three wide on both turns, lacked the necessary stretch response. BLACKTYPE (FR) tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, was forced to remain on hold, stuck along the clogged hedge starting from the five-sixteenths marker, angled into clearance midway through the furlong grounds, mustered up a mild response. MR SPEAKER reserved in the two path, waited briefly behind rivals heading for the top of the lane, altered course towards the outside with a furlong remaining, had no winning response. SHELTON accompanied the pacesetter from the two path to upper before giving way. SLOANE AVENUE saved ground to the end of the backstretch, was angled over into the overland route between the half mile pole and midpoint on the far turn, was still well off the inside swinging into the stretch, came up empty. CABRAL took up residence in midpack, was three wide and roused at the three-eighths pole, failed to pick up the pace and backed away steadily once into the stretch. After a Stewards' focusing on the stretch run as well as a claim of foul lodged by the rider of DADDY'S KID against the rider of RING WEEKEND alleging interference, the result was allowed to stand and the race was declared official.
