1 1/2 MILE. (Inner Turf) (1:45) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 Hill Prince S. INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$5,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One race allowed 3 lbs.; of a Grade Two on the turf in 2015 allowed 5 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Bay Colt, (Mar), by Harlan's Holiday - Vanquished by Empire Maker. Trainer Chad C. Brown. Bred by Dorothy A. Matz (KY).

TAKEOVER TARGET saved ground in mid pack in reserve early on, took to the two path into the far turn, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, angled three wide into upper stretch issuing a challenge to the front, dug in under a near sided stick drifting out a furlong from home while latched on to the leader, took over command just inside the sixteenth marker and inched away to the wire to prevail. VISION PERFECT established the front shortly after the start and showed the way in hand along the hedge under attendance by a pair to the outside, came under coaxing under pressure five-sixteenths from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in stubbornly under threat through the drive from the eventual winner, got headed just inside the sixteenth marker and ran on clear for the place. GREAT DANCER (IRE) broke out at the start bumping with MONEY MULTIPLIER who broke inwards, saved ground in mid pack in reserve, came under urging three furlongs from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, kept on for the show honors. WORLD APPROVAL broke in at the start forcing MONEY MULTIPLIER to steady briefly off his heels, raced three wide through the first turn, settled three to four wide near the rear in hand, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, angled six wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid for the last major share. JAY GATSBY broke in at the start bumping WINTER SPRINGS, raced three wide through the first turn, attended the pace three to four wide stacked outside a pair in hand, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the final furlong. ROYAL ALBERT HALL (GB) two to three wide in mid pack, came under a ride five-sixteenths from home, spun three wide into upper stretch and passed tired foes while making no headway on the front. MONEY MULTIPLIER traded a bump at the start with GREAT DANCER then steadied off the heels of WORLD APPEAL as that foe broke inwards taking over the lane, settled two to three wide near the rear, came under a ride five-sixteenths from home, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. TALE OF LIFE (JPN) three to four wide at the rear, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, angled out seven wide into upper stretch and offered no kick. MACHER a bit fractious in the gate, tracked the pace two to three wide in range, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch and faltered in the lane. WINTER SPRINGS (FR) bumped at the start by JAY GATSBY, attended the pace two to three wide between foes at points, came under urging midway on the far turn, swung four wide at the quarter pole in a fade and gave way in the stretch. COURTIER four then three wide through the first turn, raced just off the pace in hand four wide and in the clear, came under urging nearing the three-eighths, swung five wide at the head of the stretch and gave way.
