1 1/2 MILE. (Inner Turf) (1:45) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 Hill Prince S. INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$5,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One race allowed 3 lbs.; of a Grade Two on the turf in 2016 allowed 5 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, September 24, 2016 with 28 Nominations. (Showery 70)

Bay Colt, (Apr), by Kitten's Joy - Celestial Woods by Forestry. Trainer Chad C. Brown. Bred by Kenneth L. Ramsey & Sarah K. Ramsey (KY)

CAMELOT KITTEN bumped at the start by CONQUEST DADDYO, saved ground in mid pack early on, lost position to near the rear unhurried and biding time, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, in tandem with INSPECTOR LYNLEY to his outside, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied under an off sided stick coming inwards slightly while offering up a good kick in a well timed closing finish to get up and nail BEACH PATROL in the final jumps. BEACH PATROL just off the pace three wide, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, angled three wide into upper stretch knocking heads with MONSTER BEA through the length of the stretch taking narrow command a furlong from home, continued to tussle with that rival under some threat in behind by ANNALS OF TIME and STRIKE MIDNIGHT and under growing threat from the aforementioned foe to the outside, dug in game but was nailed in the last strides to the finish while safe for the place honors. ANNALS OF TIME three wide through the first turn, raced four wide in the clear down the backstretch just off the pace, tipped to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing now between foes five-sixteenths out, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick through the drive at times hemmed in through the final sixteenth by the eventual winner in behind BEACH PATROL and could not be fully extended at very brief periods late on to the wire. MONSTER BEA ranged up four wide through the first turn to take over command into the backstretch tucking to the two path to show the way with six and a half furlongs to run, remained patiently handed through to nearing the quarter pole as the pressure in behind and alongside intensified, continued just off the inside for home set down for the drive, dug in head to head with the runner up and was displaced a furlong out, fought on inside through to the finish but was outfinished in the final jumps in a good effort. STRIKE MIDNIGHT tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack, came under coaxing advancing mildly to swing two to three wide into upper stretch, tipped inside three-sixteenths from home and rallied up the inside to be directly behind the top pair nearing the sixteenth marker, lacked room until the final jumps to wire tepidly handled and was outfinished. INSPECTOR LYNLEY three wide through the first turn, settled just off the inside in mid pack behind the cover of BERLINER, got set down angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick but was outkicked in the late going. BERLINER three wide through the opening bend, settled just off the inside in mid pack providing the cover used by the aforementioned foe, came under urging with three furlongs remaining, angled four wide at the quarter pole, kept on through the drive on an even pace but was outkicked. CONQUEST DADDYO broke in at the start bumping CAMELOT KITTEN, settled just off the inside near the rear, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and made no impact. AMERICAN PATRIOT three to four wide through the first turn, raced five to six wide into the backstretch in the clear in range of the front, tucked to the four path half a mile out before taken to be three wide three furlongs out placed to urging, swung four wide into upper stretch, weakened in the lane. DRESSED IN HERMES saved ground through the first turn before taking to the five path into the backstretch while near the tail of the field, tucked three wide into the far turn, got spirited up three furlongs from home, angled out six wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive.
