Unearned guaranteed purse money is split between the horses that start and finish the race. Weight: 122 lbs. EXCITED saved ground stalking the pace, eased out on the far turn, circled horses entering the stretch, swept to command approaching the eighth pole then drew away under brisk urging. PINK PALLET saved ground while outrun, swung wide entering the stretch and rallied. BLUSHANDBASHFUL saved ground, was steadied in close quarters inside the five sixteenths pole, raced in the two path in upper stretch, came in near the eighth pole then rallied. FRONTSIDE chased the pace two wide and weakened the final furlong. MOUNT HOLIDAY, off the rail in the stretch, passed tired rivals. MS SILVER OAK moved up in the two path entering the stretch, remained prominent to midstretch then weakened. ANANDI, very wide entering the stretch, passed tired foes. FULL MOON BLUES set the pace along the rail, was done in upper stretch then faltered. GREEN WAVE GIRL, three wide both turns, gave way. PARADE OF COLORS, three wide the first turn, raced four wide the far turn and gave way. ART OF THE HUNT dropped back.
