1 1/8 MILE. (Turf) (1:40¹) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Hilltop S.FOR FILLIES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination. \$400 to pass the entry box. \$400 additional to start with \$100,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 1% to sixth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice at one mile or over, allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 once at one mile or over , 4 lbs.; \$50,000 at one mile or over, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Preference to starters with highest career earnings on the turf. Horses may be placed on the also-eligible list. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Tuesday May 10 , 2016 with 51 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management torun this race on the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth). (Clear 71)

GONE AWAY was rated back from between rivals soon after the break, dropped in to settle, gathered momentum leaving the five sixteenths, angled out very wide for the drive, closed stoutly under repeated left handed rousing, forged ahead in deep stretch then prevailed. FAMILY MEETING was taken back and unhurried well off the pace while saving ground, continued well back for six furlongs, eased out and awaited room in upper stretch, advanced quickly between runners leaving the eighth pole, dove down towards the inside for room leaving the sixteenth marker and closed strongly to just miss. WESSEX advanced into the first turn to get position then was taken to rate, moved up four wide into the lane, rallied under pressure to engage THUNDERING SKY past the eighth pole, gained a slim lead late and kept on gamely. MISS KATIE MAE (IRE) bobbed at the break, recovered and settled off the rail, angled five wide progressing into the lane, ranged up outside rivals inside eighth pole and kept on willingly to close the gap. THUNDERING SKY , under a nice hold in closest pursuit past the half, got through along the rail entering the lane, spurted clear while drifting off the rail then could not resist challengers in the final sixteenth. KOALA QUEEN , between rivals, moved up nearing mid stretch then flattened out. CHANNEL REGATTA broke outward and bumped with a foe, steadied when put in close soon after, lost ground five wide leaving the far turn then had a mild late response. MELODY CROON saved ground, waited briefly near the three eighths, angled out to progress then flattened out. LOOKOUT SISTER saved ground leaving the far turn, angled out then needed more between past the eighth pole. LA PIBA , bumped at the break, raced wide the first turn, moved up a bit between runners in mid stretch then failed to sustain. SPINAMISS (IRE) saved ground, eased out in upper stretch and faded. COWGIRL TOUGH gave early pursuit inside, angled out near the quarter pole and weakened. LOOK WHO'S TALKING saved ground leaving the half mile pole and gave way. MORETHANJUSTHELLO had her rider lose his right iron at the break, failed to recover it and ran off to a lengthy lead, had her rider decide to drop the left foot out of the stirrup near the five sixteenths while beginning a retreat, altered out entering the lane and was eased.
