MAJESTIC CITY close up stalking the pace outside a rival, continued off the inside in midstretch, surged under urging to the front three deep a sixteenth out and won clear. BRIGAND broke in a bit, pulled his way up inside to stalk the pace, was kept on the rail by the winner on the turn, bid along the fence in midstretch, reached even terms with the pacesetter past the eighth pole, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but was second best. NIGHT TIDE sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, battled outside the runner-up in midstretch, was between horses a sixteenth out and clearly bested the others. PEND OREILLE chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. SUPER CANDY settled outside a rival then saved ground off the pace, went around a foe into the stretch and did not rally. RINO S broke slowly, went up inside to chase the pace, dropped back on the turn and gave way, then was not persevered with late.
