1½ MILES. (Turf) (.00) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 **HOLLYWOOD TURF CUP S. (GRADE II) FOR THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD.** By subscription of \$250 each to accompany the nomination. Closed Thursday, November 13, 2014 with 15. Or by supplementary nomination of \$2,500 each by the closing time of entries. \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,750 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to first, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. Three-year-olds 122 lbs. Older 126 lbs. Non-winners of a Gr I at a mile or over in 2013-14 allowed 2 lbs., a Gr II at a mile or over in 2013-14 allowed 4 lbs., a Gr III at a mile or over in 2013-14 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the closing time of entries. This race will not be divided. If the number of entries exceed fourteen(144), first preference will be given to Gr I or Gr II winners in 2014. Second preference will be given to horses placed (second or third) in a Gr I or Gr II or Gr III winners in 2014. Total non-claiming earnings in 2014 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses with equal status. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Rail at 6 feet). (Clear 78)

FINNEGANS WAKE chased between horses then outside a rival, continued inside on the final turn, waited some then got through toward the inside into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. PATRIOTICANDPROUD chased inside, split horses on the final turn, came out into the stretch and rallied between foes late. THE PIZZA MAN chased three deep then off the rail or outside a rival, bid alongside the leader to gain the advantage in upper stretch, inched away past midstretch and was caught late. POWER FOOT chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the last turn and was outfinished. LITTLE JERRY had speed outside a rival then chased inside, split rivals to gain the lead a half mile out, kicked clear inside, battled in midstretch and weakened late. IRISH SURF broke in the air and slowly, settled outside a rival, went three deep on the last turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BENCH LIGHT chased three deep then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. HOLIDAY STAR unhurried along the inside early, moved up some approaching the last turn then went outside a rival on that turn and lacked the needed rally in the lane. STONEY FLEECE saved ground off the pace, split horses into the final turn, continued inside on that turn and did not rally. MYSTERY TRAIN (ARG) had speed inside and dueled briefly then opened up on the first turn, widened to a lengthy lead under a long hold through the stretch the first time, set the pace inside, offered little resistance when challenged leaving the backstretch, gave way and was eased in the lane.
