POTESTA stalked outside a rival and was between horses midway on the backstretch, continued alongside a foe into the second turn, bid alongside the runner-up, put a head in front in midstretch, responded gamely when headed in deep stretch, bumped with EDEN'S MOON and narrowly prevailed under some left handed urging and vigorous handling. EDEN'S MOON had speed inside then dueled a bit off the rail, battled between foes briefly then outside a rival on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn, fought back along the fence through the stretch, bumped with the winner in deep stretch and put a head back in front late then continued willingly to the wire. VIA VILLAGGIO chased between horses then settled a bit off the rail, found the inside on the second turn, got through along the rail into and through the stretch and bested the others. KILLER GRACES stalked three deep then off the rail, continued outside on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. STARLIGHT MAGIC saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. WILLA B AWESOME pulled her way along inside to stalk the pace, bid along the rail on the backstretch, dueled for the lead, steadied in tight into the second turn, continued inside and weakened. OPEN WATER chased between horses then a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival on the second turn and lacked a response in the drive. CUSTOMER BASE settled outside a rival chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally.
