SWITCH pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside, came off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead a sixteenth out, inched clear and held gamely. BLIND LUCK settled off the rail, moved up leaving the second turn, advanced toward the inside in upper stretch, came out past midstretch and finished willingly but could not catch the winner.

CAMILLE C took the early lead and set a moderate pace along the inside, shook off a rival nearing the second turn and kicked clear, fought back past midstretch and held third. ANTARES WORLD chased off the inside, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. VISION IN GOLD stalked the pace outside a rival then bid alongside CAMILLE C on the backstretch, tracked that one again on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
