PREMIER PEGASUS had speed three deep to set a pressured pace, inched away and angled in on the backstretch, dueled inside on the turn, inched away again in the stretch, kicked clear, drifted out a bit from the whip past midstretch and held sway under urging. INDUSTRY LEADER prompted the pace between horses then stalked outside a rival or between foes, re-bid three deep leaving the backstretch, tracked the leaders off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and continued willingly to be second best. AWESOME PATRIOT went up inside to force the pace then stalked, came out leaving the backstretch, re-bid between horses into the turn, dueled alongside the winner on the turn, drifted inward in deep stretch and held third. CONTEMPLATED between foes early, angled in and chased inside the rest of the way and lacked the needed late kick. HIGH LEVEL JEFF pulled his way along three deep early then chased off the rail, lugged out a bit on the backstretch, angled in some for the turn and could not offer the necessary response. NORTHERN INDY a bit slow to begin, moved up three deep on the backstretch to chase the pace, continued outside on the turn and three wide into the stretch and weakened.
