KILLER GRACES chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into and leaving the second turn, entered the stretch three deep, gained the advantage three wide in midstretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. CHARM THE MAKER pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside, came a bit off the rail on the second turn, bid between horses into and through the stretch and continued willingly inside the winner late. LADY PECAN sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back along the fence into and through the stretch, could not quite match the top pair late but held third. WEEMISSFRANKIE stumbled at the start, came off the inside early, chased off the rail, went around a rival on the second turn and a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally but put in a late bid at a minor award. SELF PRESERVATION three deep into the first turn, chased just off the rail, went around a tiring foe on the second turn and could not offer the necessary response. MI VIDA stalked the pace outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
