PURE FUN settled off the pace while saving ground, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied while drifting in some under left handed urging and energetic handling to gain the lead a sixteenth out and proved best. BLONDE FOG had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the backstretch, responded when a rival loomed into the stretch, kicked clear, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but clearly bested the others. SCARLET STRIKE angled in on the first turn and chased inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. EXECUTIVEPRIVILEGE between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail, inched forward inside into the second turn, came out leaving that turn and into the stretch to loom a threat behind the runner-up but weakened in the final furlong. MIDNIGHT BALLET settled outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. RENEE'S TITAN chased three deep then outside a rival, split horses on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. MISS EMPIRE chased inside then off the rail, went outside then three and four wide on the second turn, continued three deep into the stretch and also weakened. RHODIUM angled in and dueled outside the runner-up, stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch then outside a rival into the second turn, dropped back on that turn, angled to the inside into the stretch and gave way.
