HOLY CANDY chased off the rail then outside a rival, swung out into the stretch, was three deep in midstretch, rallied under a left handed crack of the whip and steady handling while lugging in some to gain the lead in deep stretch and won clear. EATON HALL broke out a bit, tugged his way to the early lead off the rail, angled in some and set a moderate pace just off the fence under a rating hold, remained clear past midstretch, could not hold off the winner late but saved the place. SEAL THE DEAL broke slowly, saved ground chasing the pace throughout and bested the others. STRATIFY stumbled when the ground broke out behind at the start, angled in on the first turn, settled inside, came out on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and lacked a rally. GOPHARI reluctant to load, went into the first turn in the four path, angled in and stalked the leader off the rail, was between horses in midstretch and weakened.
