WELL MONIED unhurried outside early, moved up three deep into the second turn, came three wide into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, inched away and held under some urging. ACTING LADY stalked three deep then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and finished well to be second best. LEXLENOS (IRE) allowed to settle a bit off the rail then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and just got the show. CENTURY PARK saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and again late and just missed third. DAYLUMNEY (IRE) pulled early, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn and lacked the needed response in the stretch. DASH DOT DASH between horses early, angled in and stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid alongside a rival leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, took a short lead in midstretch but weakened in the final furlong. CANDILEJAS allowed to settle a bit off the rail then inside, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat. MAID FOR MUSIC (IRE) stalked a bit off the inside then along the fence on the backstretch and second turn, came out a bit in the stretch and weakened. PRIDE DANCER (IRE) pulled her way along outside a rival to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled along the fence on the second turn and to midstretch and weakened.
