HAVEYOUGONEAWAY away in good order, took up position in the two path, was coaxed keeping watch as a group comprised of four went at it, got called uipon spinning four wide into the stretch, closed in to begin the final furlong as the chief threat to PAULASSILVERLINING, maintained the momentum and made steady progress on that foe, got up in final forty yards to prove best. PAULASSILVERLINING remained towards the inside after the break, was kept reserved within striking distance of the hotly-contested pace, inched her way off the inside route

approaching the quarter pole, angled three wide into the stretch, took over soon afterwards, had the pilot take a peek back in midstretch before put to a drive, showed good determination before yielding in the final stages. DISCO CHICK gained a narrow advantage after the start, cut over to the inside, showed the way, being hounded by a threesome of opponents to her outside nearly all the way to the quarter pole, had the second place finisher draw up to her stepping into the stretch and was switched to a drive, gave in in short order and steadily backed away. LA MADRINA off a half length the slowest, darted over to the rail, rode it, rider applying a snug grip on the left side, felt the whip cutting the corner into the stretch, lacked a response. SARAH SIS settled into the three path, vied from middle of rivals for command, got set down as the half was being completed, kept up the pursuit in earnest for a few more jumps then gave way. DIVA EXPRESS went into the two path after the start, fought from between rivals for the lead for approximately a half before faltering. BAR OF GOLD put to some brisk hand urging leaving the gate, rushed up keenly to confront the front runners, was in the four path, the widest of four contesting the lead, got put to a drive after beginning to fall back coming to the
