CURRENCY SWAP was taken in hand then moved to the outside when TRINNIBERG passed in front early, moved up while urged along, chased three wide on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, drifted out near the furlong marker, battled on the outside under a strong drive, drifted out a late while overhauling the leader and prevailed under strong handling. TRINNIBERG broke very alertly then was hustled, crossed over some and set the pace, controlled the action on the turn, was set down in upper stretch, drifted out inside the furlong marker, lost the lead just inside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while clear for the place. BIG BLUE NATION lost his footing at the start and was last away, raced at the back of the field while ridden along, saved ground early on the turn, shifted two to three wide nearing the five-sixteenths pole, espied an opening and altered back to the inside, came through along the rail passing the quarter-pole, drifted out under left hand urging in upper stretch, was switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and finished willingly for the show. LAURIE'S ROCKET was ridden along towards the rear, raced five wide on the turn and improved position. POWER WORLD was ridden along while off the pace, raced two then three wide early on the turn, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. I'LL HAVE ANOTHER was ridden along near the back of the field, raced five wide early on the turn then dropped to three wide, moved to the rail by the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. HUNT CROSSING bumped with VEXOR after the start, showed early speed, was taken in hand when TRINNIBERG tightened it up, raced towards the front while under urging, saved ground early on the turn, came off the inside near the five-sixteenths pole and capitulated. VEXOR bumped with HUNT CROSSING after the start, showed early speed, was taken in hand near the five-eighths pole, chased the pace, went two then three wide on the turn and stopped. CLIP THE COUPONS was urged along while off the pace, went three wide on the turn and failed to respond. J C'S PRIDE lunged at the start but broke towards the front, was ridden along on the outside, went four wide early on the turn, was taken wider near the three-eighths pole and pulled up then vanned off.
