PRACTICAL JOKE tracked the pace in hand along the inside behind the leader, came under light coaxing three furlongs from home, tipped out two then three wide into upper stretch straightened away, rallied to latch on the top pair a furlong out, tussled through the final eighth taking

the rest for the show honors. BITUMEN hustled from the gate, chased five then four wide down the backstretch before being put to prolonged urging seven-sixteenths out when tucked to the three path, chased three wide through the bend, swung four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. EVERYBODYLUVSRUDY two to three wide in pursuit from the tail of the field albeit among a compact group, got coaxed along three furlongs from home, angled three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. RUNAWAY LUTE a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, chased three wide in range of the duel put to encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, angled five wide into upper stretch, faltered in the lane,

then fell after the finish and was subsequently walked off. CLASSIC EMPIRE wheeled outwards at the start to the outside rail unseating the rider in the process and was subsequently vanned off. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the start focusing on CLASSIC EMPIRE before the race was
