**1<sup>st</sup> MILES. (1.463) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 ILLINOIS DERBY (GRADE III) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS.** By subscription of \$100 each Early Bird nomination made by Friday, February 14, 2014 or \$500 each, which shall accompany the nomination made by Saturday, April 5, 2014. A Supplementary nomination of \$10,000 may be made on Wednesday, April 16, 2014 which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$2,500 to pass the entry box and \$2,500 additional to start. All fees to be paid to the Horsemen's Bookkeeper prior to the start of the race. The entry and starting fees for the 2014 Illinois Derby will be refunded for any horse that has previously finished 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any Grade/Group I, II or III race and is an official starter in the 2014 Illinois Derby. \$500,000 guaranteed with 60 percent to the winning owner, 20 percent to second, 11 percent to third, 6 percent to fourth and 3 percent to fifth. Weights: Colts and Geldings, 122 lbs.; Fillies, 117 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Early Closing, Friday, February 14, 2014 with 112 (\$100 Fee). Late Closing, Saturday, April 5, 2014 with 11 (\$500 Fee). 1 Supplementary - Time of Entry, Wednesday, April 16, 2014. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Clear 60)

DYNAMIC IMPACT broke readily to gain terms with the first flight nearest the inside attending the pace in the opening stages, was urged to prompt a rival's tempo entering the backstretch, continued in that fashion into the second bend, lost some ground to the leader while shifting outside that foe nearing upper stretch but continued with a steady late response to reel in that rival in the final stages, narrowly prevailing under strong handling. MIDNIGHT HAWK bobbled at the start, recovered quickly, was prompted to join the pace between foes racing to the first turn to gain the advantage in the second furlong, dictated the pace on a narrow margin outside a rival into the second bend, edged forward of that rival nearing upper stretch while shifting to the inside, maintained that advantage past midstretch, grudgingly resisted the winner's challenge and was just outnoddod on the wire. IRISH YOU WELL, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening five furlongs, shifted out splitting foes on the far turn, swung out four wide nearing upper stretch and continued with a steady late effort to gain some position while no menace to the top pair. CLASS LEADER broke inwards bumping GLOBAL STRIKE, was prompted four deep in the opening furlong to gain a position just off the leaders, tracked the pacesetter from within striking distance three deep to the far turn, was urged to maintain that position racing into the lane but steadily faded in late stages. KING CYRUS tracked just off the first flight three deep racing to the far turn but had no closing response when called upon. A STEP AHEAD was a brief factor between foes in the second flight in the opening half but retreated from contention early. EMMETT PARK, bumped while caught in close quarters at the start, was reserved between foes in the last flight racing to the first turn, never mounted a serious challenge. GLOBAL STRIKE, bumped, then caught in tight quarters at the break, was settled four wide racing to the backstretch and dropped out early.
