FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND OLDER, WHERE AT LEAST 51% OF THE HORSES' RECORDED OWNERSHIP IS REGISTERED TO AN OWNER WHOSE ILLINOIS RACING BOARD LICENSE REGISTRATION REFLECTS AN ADDRESS IN THE STATE OF ILLINOIS.* Nominations close Thursday, August 4, 2011 with no fee. \$100 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$60,000 Added of which 60% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHTS: Three-Year-Olds, 121 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-W innerers of \$40,000 at a mile or over in 2011, allowed 2 lbs. Non-Winnerers of \$25,000 at a mile or over in 2011, 4 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races are not considered in estimating allowances.) The field will be limited to 12 starters. Highweights on the scale preferred. Total earnings in 2010-2011 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Nominations Closed Thursday, August 4, 2011, with 23 nominations. Lane 1. (If the management considers it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf Course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth). (Clear 77)

Bay Gelding, (May), by Roar of the Tiger - Empress of All by Nasty and Bold. Trainer Janks K. Christine. Bred by Carson Springs Farm(IL).

TAZZ, prominent five deep in the opening furlong, was taken in hand to be reserved off the first flight while angling to the rail entering the first turn, continued under reserve while steadily drawing into striking position inside foes on the second bend, shifted out when presented an opening nearing the furlong marker, then wrested command and edged forward in time under steady handling. EXCHANGING KISSES moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin while in hand to the second bend, was roused racing into the stretch to maintain his advantage but couldn't fend off the winner. COOL C NOTE stalked just off the pacesetter under rating in the opening half, moved to press the issue between foes on the far turn to upper stretch but couldn't match the top pair late. CROSS VILLAGE, caught four wide in the opening stages, continued three deep into the backstretch racing just off the leaders, made a brief bid in that path entering the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. MY SONNY BOY, reserved in last racing to the far turn, angled six wide entering upper stretch and made some mild progress. QUICK DELIVERY, close up three deep between foes in the opening furlong, was eased off the leaders to track those foes off the inside from out of striking distance racing to the second bend but couldn't make an impression on the leaders. HOODWINKED was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch, angled out five wide entering upper stretch but lacked a closing response. HATTAASH, reserved along the inside to the second bend, never mounted a serious challenge.
