BLINGO bumped from both sides and squeezed between at the start, came under light coaxing while three to four wide towards the rear, advanced from that path into the far turn into prominence three furlongs out, came under encouragement swinging four wide for home, rallied to seize command narrowly a furlong out, dug in under challenge coming in under off sided stick work perhaps to get a better look at his main threat and repulsed that foe to the wire to prevail. DON DULCE broke out at the start bumping his entry mate into BLINGO and effectively squeezing both out mildly in tandem with PERCUSSION who broke inwards, tracked from just off the inside under light coaxing, got roused and angled to the rail at the head of the stretch, rallied along the inside to be the main threat a furlong out but was ultimately repulsed to the wire despite kicking on with good energy. PRAETEREO bumped by his entry mate who broke out and in turn bumped BLINGO then was squeezed mildly out in tandem with that rival, settled two to three wide towards the rear, got shifted out a path three furlongs out commencing a drive, angled four wide for home, offered up a mild kick to be along for the show. PERCUSSION broke in at the start bumping BLINGO, squeezed that foe out mildly in tandem with DON DULCE who caused equal pressure from the inside, came under coaxing to vie inside of FARHAAN, got placed to a drive at the five-sixteenths when narrowly headed, cornered just off the inside for home, reestablished the front briefly before yielding for good nearing the eighth pole then weakened through to the wire. FARHAAN away well, vied in hand from just off the inside, took narrow command briefly at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home roused for the drive and weakened through the stretch. FAST FALCON forwardly placed three wide, bid inside the eventual winner BLINGO to midway on the turn into prominence, lost position at the three-eighths unable to keep his lane, shifted to the two path at that juncture, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch and made no headway.
