After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, the remainder of the purse will be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-Winners of \$60,000 onceat a mile or over or \$30,000 twice at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs; of \$30,000 at a mile or over 4 lbs; of three races other than maiden or claiming 6 lbs. Maiden, claiming, starter, and state bred races will not be considered when estimating allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Should more than twelve horses pass the entry box preference will be given to (1) Grade/Group 1 winners, (2) Grade/Group 2 winners and Grade/Group 1 place finishers, (3) Grade/Group 3 winners and Grade/Group 2 place finishers, Grade/Group 3 place finishers, (4) Listed winners, (5) Highest Lifetime Earnings. Closed on Friday, June 28, 2019 with 41 nominations. (Clear 91)

MR. MONEY stalked the pace from the three path through the first turn and into the backstretch, continued with an eye on the leaders while remaining in the three path approaching the far turn, dropped in to the two path to avoid a loose horse, shifted back into the three path and began gaining momentum in mid-turn, bid two wide and still in the three path near the five-sixteenths pole, cleared while straightening into the lane and settling into the two path, widened to eighth pole and continued to slowly stretch the advantage to the wire while being kept busy. GRAY MAGICIAN tracked the pacesetters while along the inside into the far turn, came off the inside after mid-turn while passing a tired rival, entered the lane from the three path when being asked for more, was brushed by MATH WIZARD outside the eighth pole and forced in a bit, continued on while moving further off the inside and outfinished that one for the place spot although not a menace to the winner. MATH WIZARD was unhurried while traveling through the three path into the backstretch, moved closer into the far turn, was under strong handling and moving with intent through late turn, came into the lane from the three or four path, moved in to avoid a loose rival, brushed with the runner-up then could not advance further while finishing best of the rest. CHESS CHIEF raced in the two path through the turns when near the back, bid into late turn, came into the lane from the three path and moved up while never a serious threat. LONG RANGE TODDY pressed the pacesetter while two wide into the far turn, bid just before the winner after mid-turn, gained the lead in late turn, could not go with the top one straightening into the lane then faded along the rail. FROLIC MORE was in a bit tight at the start and settled back, raced in the two path through the turns, came into the lane with some momentum, settled in the three path for the drive then flattened out nearing the sixteenth pole. ROILAND was along the inside through the first turn, continued off the rail into the far turn while well back and never demonstrated a serious response while passing a couple of tired ones. HERO TIGER chased the pace while along the inside, slowly lost ground through the far turn and was empty entering the lane. ALWAYSMINING set the pace from the outset while along the inside, felt pressure from another into the far turn, continued under pressure through the turn then dropped out just after the guarter pole and retreated. MARKET GARDEN was always last while racing near the inside. ESKENFORIT stumbled to his nose at the start and lost his rider, continued on racing with the leaders while in the three path, bothered the winner near the seven-sixteenths pole and the show rival near the three-sixteenths pole then continued on without incident.
