BLAME THE FROG broke out at the start and raced back early on, fanned into the seven path in the turn, rallied in the stretch with a late gain in the final stages. CREDIT SWAP chased the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. HIDE THE DEMON was back early on, steadied nearing the five sixteenth pole, angled off the rail turn and leveled off late in the stretch. NITROUS was bumped and bothered at the start with some gain in the stretch run. MISTER BANJOMAN set the pace early, was on the inside into the lane, remained clear in the stretch but faltered late in the drive. THE SICARII was never a threat. JO JO AIR bobbled at the start, tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn and was empty down the lane.
