**1 1/4 MILES. (1.41) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 INDIANA DERBY (GRADE II) (PLUS UP TO 40% ITDF) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.** By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination \$400 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$500,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through h last, the purse will be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs, Fillies: 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2010, allowed 3 lbs; of \$30,000 at any distance in 2010, 5 lb s; three races otherthan maiden or claiming, 7 lbs; two such races, 9 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This stake will be limited to twelve starters. If more than twelve horses pass the entry box, preference will be given to (1)) Grade/Group 1 winners, (2) Grade/Group 2 winners and Grade/Group 1 place finishers, (3) Grade/Group 3 and Grade/Group 2 place finishers, (4) Highest Lifetime Earnings. Two horses having common ties through horse ownership cannot st art to the exclusionof a single interest. Entry fee only will be refunded if failure to draw into the race. (Cloudy 60)

Bay Colt, (May), by Smart Strike - Private Feeling by Belong to Me. Trainer Baffert Bob. Bred by Gulf Coast Farms LLC(KY).  
LOOKIN AT LUCKY void of speed and outside, circled the field through the second turn, came widest into the stretch, made a steady gain and drove clear late. THISKYHASNOLIMIT tracked the early pace inside while pulling, split rivals through the backstretch to gain a short lead into the second turn, then gained a clear lead into the stretch, drifted out through the lane and was no threat to the winner while best of the rest. ST. MAXIMUS GATO stalked the early pace outside, moved up to loop rivals five wide through the second turn, angled in and bid three wide into the stretch, then drifted in and weakened the final furlong. WORLDLY well placed and between rivals, moved up to vie for the lead into the second turn, then angled in and came through inside of rivals into the stretch, altered out and could not gain in the lane. LITIGATION RISK well placed and three wide, gained a striking position on the two path through the second turn, bid into the stretch and had no rally. UAREOUTLAW (BRZ) passed tiring rivals. INDY BULL set the early pace off the rail, gained a clear lead quickly, then faded after a half. NACHO FRIEND mid pack and outside, moved up to loop rivals six wide through the second turn and faltered. DABOSSMAN was never involved.
