FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD FOALING IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY.* No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 may be paid by time of entry. \$600 to pass the entry box and \$650 to start. All starters including supplements will be required to pay all fees. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three year olds, 122 lbs. Older, 1 24 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake since July 1, 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstake in 2010, 5 lbs.; three races, 7 lbs.(maiden,claiming and starter races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, October 9, 2010 with 20 nominations and 1 supplement. (Clear 62)

Bay Mare, (May), by Rock and Roll - Meeses Pieces by Grindstone. Trainer Barker R. Edward. Bred by Robert W. Misa Jr.(NY).

MEESE ROCKS broke running, quickly established command, carved the pace from the inside on a loosely-contested lead, well rated until the three-sixteenths pole, spurred away when let out a notch, then maintained a safe margin throughout the final furlong under steady encouragement. R BETTY GRAYBULL bumped after the break, bided her time while racing towards the inside during the opening half, was taken outward approaching the quarter pole, worked her way over to the middle of the strip by the three-sixteenths pole, took off after being asked for a response, and finished with good energy down the outside to garner the place. MY DINAH raced off the inside, was taken in hand to remain well to the inside of a troubled rival in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, angled outward turning for home and rallied willingly en route for the show. MOTHER RUSSIA tracked the leader from the rail, attempted to bull her way off the inside coming to the three-eighths pole, bumping with LOVELY LIL and causing that rival to lose stride and stumble as a result, proceeded to get outkicked during the stretch run. LOVELY LIL raced within striking distance, was bumped into by MOTHER RUSSIA midway on the turn, stumbling soon afterwards, got going again, but lacked the necessary stretch response after turning for home. CITY BROAD came inward a bit start, creating enough pressure to force R BETTY GRAYBULL into CODY SAMORA, moved up to assume a forward position, gave chase three wide, attempted to issue a challenge for the lead coming to the quarter pole, wasn't up to the task, steadily tiring leaving the furlong grounds. SHINE UPON rushed up after the start, took the inside route until slipping out around the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed kick after entering the stretch. FIVEFIFTEEN was steadied after exchanging a couple of light bumps with KARAKORUM FUGITIVE at the start, and failed to reach a contending position. KARAKORUM FUGITIVE bumped at the start, made a middle move on the turn but had little left after turning for home. SAPPHIRE SKY strung out four wide at the three-eighths pole, tired. CODY SAMORA broke open the gate prior to the start, was bumped and forced to be taken in hand leaving the gate, raced wide and tired. After a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident on turn, MOTHER RUSSIA was disqualified from fourth and placed fifth for causing interference on the turn.
